

THE BARBADOS YACHT CLUB LAWN TENNIS REGULATIONS

1. LAWN TENNIS COMMITTEE

The Lawn tennis Committee shall be responsible for the administration of all Lawn Tennis organized by the Club.

2. RENTAL OF COURTS

Courts shall be available for rental as follows:

8:00 am to 3:30 pm

Monday to Sunday, 4 courts, except during school holidays, when only 2 courts shall be available.

\$15.00 per hour, no balls supplied.

4:00 pm to 6:00 pm:

Monday, Wednesday, Thursday Friday & Sunday

\$30.00 per court for two periods

Tuesday: non bookable

\$30.00 for two hours

Saturday No charge

6:00 pm to 9:00 pm

Monday to Saturday.

Sunday 6:00 pm to 7:15 pm

\$24.00 per hour for the 1st hour, \$15.00 per hour thereafter

The Club Bar shall remain open until 9:00 pm, Monday, to Saturday if courts have been booked and the players are present, The Barman on duty shall be responsible for the control of the courts and shall see that the lights are turned on and off at the arranged times. He shall turn the lights off promptly and finally at 9: pm Monday to Saturday and at 7:15 pm on Sundays.

3. **BOOKINGS or CANCELLATIONS of BOOKINGS:** shall be made at the Bar as early as possible before play, preferably not later than the previous day for night tennis, so that staff may be arranged for when necessary.
If a court is booked and is not used, and was not cancelled by 12: noon on the day of play, the full Rental charge shall be made.

Bookings may not be made more than two weeks in advance.

A member may book only one court per session.

A member or member's spouse must book a court for children over 16 who are not junior members **MUST** play with them.

Full members have priority over Junior members.

All Courts must be paid for on collection of balls

New Tennis Balls will be issued on Monday, Wednesday and Friday

4. OPEN TENNIS:

Saturday 4: 00 pm to 6:00 pm all courts shall be available to members only for Open Tennis.

TOURNAMENTS:

Members will be given two weeks notice of the commencement date and the estimated termination date by placing an appropriate notice on the notice board and in the tennis book in the Bar.

PRACTICE:

On Saturdays and Sundays two courts shall be available to members only from 6:30 am to 3:30 pm for practice. No balls shall be provided, but may be purchased from the office. Play periods shall be half hour each.

PRACTICE COURT

The practice court shall be used only for lawn tennis practice.

CHILDRENS TENNIS

Two courts shall be available for use of members children only (under 16 years of age) on Saturdays and Sundays from 6:30 am to 3:30 pm. No balls shall be provided. Play periods shall be half hour each.

DRESS

Players shall not be allowed on courts unless they are wearing correct tennis dress. Swimwear is not permitted. Tennis shoes must be worn. Vest type tops are not considered correct tennis wear.

The Lawn Tennis Committee, having considered the observation of several members, sought and obtained ratification from Management to amend the Regulations relating to rental of the courts from 3:30 pm to Sundown on Tuesday evenings only.

With effect from July 1st 1993 the regulations relating to the rental of courts from 3:30 pm to Sundown on Tuesday of each week will revert to former Regulations namely.

- (a) AGE LIMIT No children under 16 years of age shall participate in adult make-up tennis, except in cases approved by the Lawn Tennis Committee for reasons of exceptional ability.
- (b) SINGLES Two sets of singles shall not be played at the same time if there is four waiting, but if for want of sufficient fours two sets of singles have already started, then they may be completed

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- (c) NOTIFICATION OF PLAY One person in each four (or two singles) shall register his or her name in the book provided for this purpose when all four or two singles players are present and ready to play again after the finish of each set. Thus, the turn on the next vacant court will be in the same rotation as shown by the order of the names in the book. Each person whose name is registered in the book will pay the charge mentioned above.
- (d) NUMBER OF PLAYERS. A “four” is defined as four players – not three, five or six members.

Playing members are asked to note Section (e) above regarding the responsibility of payment of the appropriate charge.
